SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 44

A RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE MISSISSIPPI CHAPTER OF THE LINKS, 1 INC., FOR THEIR SUPPORT OF LEGISLATION ADDRESSING THE ELIMINATION 2. OF HEALTH DISPARITIES AND WELCOMING THEM ON THE OCCASION OF "LINKS 3 4 DAY AT THE CAPITOL" ON MARCH 24, 2005. 5 WHEREAS, the Southern Area of The Links, Inc., and its members, Black women from Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Louisiana, 6 Mississippi, North Carolina and South Carolina, will gather in 7 their individual state's capitol cities to let their legislative 8 9 representatives know that they want 'Healthy People 2010' 10 legislation passed by their state legislatures. These women are members of The Links, Incorporated, an organization of more than 11 10,000 members who are linked together by 275 chapters around the 12 globe in order to enrich, sustain and ensure the identities, 13 culture and economic survival of all people of African origin; and 14 WHEREAS, "Links Day at the Capitol" is a project of the 15 Southern Area of The Links. There are 2,500 members in 75 16 17 chapters of The Links in the Southern Area. The Links hope to have an impact on their state capitols and flex the collective 18 19 organizational strength and influence of their membership. Visitations at state capitols will begin in February and will be 20 21 scheduled through the end of varying state legislative sessions. The Links State Project Coordinator for the State of Mississippi 22 is Angela Miller from the Natchez Chapter of The Links, Inc.; and 23 24 WHEREAS, in conducting "Links Day at the Capitol," Links will meet with their state legislators in small groups to communicate 25 26 and bring awareness to a unified Links message, the elimination of 2.7 health disparities.
