REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 517: Certain local natural gas districts; add municipal/county system-users to board of directors for.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

10 SECTION 1. Section 77-15-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 11 amended as follows:

12 77-15-1. (1) Notwithstanding any other provisions of law to 13 the contrary, all local natural gas districts containing two (2) 14 or more municipalities and nonmunicipal customers shall establish and maintain a board of directors composed of: (a) the mayors of 15 16 each municipality within the district whose terms shall be concurrent with their terms of office as mayor; and (b) one (1) 17 18 system-user from each county within the district, who shall not be a public official. The county system-user board members shall be 19 20 elected by the system-users residing outside of a municipality, in the county in which such board member resides. In order to 21 22 qualify as a candidate for election to the board, each person 23 shall obtain, on a petition, twenty-five (25) signatures from 2.4 system-users in the county in which such person resides. The signatures shall be of system-users residing outside of a 25 municipality and the candidate shall be a system-user who resides 26 27 outside of a municipality. The board shall call an election within fifteen (15) days after July 1, 1989, to be held within 28 29 sixty (60) days from the date such election is called. Those persons elected to the board shall serve until the next general 30

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election for supervisors and the election for such board members 31 32 thereafter shall be held at the same time as the supervisor elections and the terms of such board members shall be concurrent 33 34 with the terms of the supervisors. The board of directors, 35 including any mayors who serve on the board, shall be entitled to compensation as follows: (a) the chairperson of the board shall 36 receive Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) per month, and (b) all 37 other board members shall receive Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) 38 39 per month. Only mayors of the board shall serve as chairperson and such mayors shall serve annually on a rotating basis. 40 41 (2) Two (2) board municipal/county system-user board members who reside in his or her respective county, and must be customers 42 of the district, and who must be system-users shall be appointed 43 44 as follows for his or her initial term: (a) one (1) board member from the county lying in the northern section of the district, 45 46 appointed by the Lieutenant Governor; and (b) one (1) board member from the county lying in the southern section of the district, 47 48 appointed by the Governor. The appointed board municipal/county system-user board members may be elected public officials. 49 The initial terms of the two (2) municipal/county system-user 50 board members shall begin July 1, 2005, and shall serve until the 51 next general election for supervisors, and thereafter the 52 53 municipal/county system-user board members, as described in this 54 subsection (2), shall be elected at large by the municipal and 55 county system-users. The municipal/county system-user board members shall be 56 compensated as prescribed in subsection (1) of this section. 57 (3) All board members shall file any required statements of 58 59 economic interest with the Ethics Commission as required by law. 60 This section shall not apply to any local natural gas district 61 which leases its distribution system to an investor-owned utility 62 company regulated by the Public Service Commission.

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(4) From and after July 1, 2004, the Board of Directors of 63 64 the Chickasawhay Natural Gas District shall discontinue distribution of any of the revenues of the district to 65 66 municipalities within the district. (5) The provisions of this section shall not apply to the 67 Northeast Mississippi Natural Gas District created under Chapter 68 69 309, Laws of 1996; nor shall the provisions apply to the Caledonia Natural Gas District created under Chapter 834, Laws of 1988. 70 71 (6) This section shall stand repealed on July 1, 2006. SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 72 73 and after July 1, 2005.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 77-15-1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 PROVIDE THE COMPENSATION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF NATURAL GAS 2 3 DISTRICTS; TO PROVIDE THAT ONLY MAYORS SHALL SERVE AS THE CHAIRPERSON OF THE BOARD; TO PROVIDE THAT TWO MUNICIPAL/COUNTY 4 SYSTEM-USER MEMBERS SHALL BE APPOINTED TO THE BOARD FOR THEIR 5 INITIAL TERMS, AND AFTER THE EXPIRATION OF THE INITIAL TERMS SUCH 6 7 MEMBERS SHALL BE ELECTED; TO ADD A REPEAL DATE ON THIS SECTION; 8 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
