MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1317: Health insurance; require reimbursement for services of marriage and family therapists.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 72 Section 73-31-3. A duly licensed professional counselor shall be
- 73 entitled to participate in such policies, plans or contracts
- 74 providing for the diagnosis and treatment of mental, nervous or
- 75 emotional disorders only as authorized by Section 73-30-3. A duly
- 76 licensed clinical social worker shall be entitled to participate
- 77 in such policies, plans or contracts providing for the diagnosis
- 78 and treatment of mental, nervous or emotional disorders only as
- 79 authorized by Section 73-53-3.
- 80 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 81 and after July 1, 2005.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 83-41-211, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT CERTAIN INSURANCE POLICIES SHALL PROVIDE

- REIMBURSEMENT FOR SERVICES RENDERED BY MARRIAGE AND FAMILY
- THERAPISTS FOR THE TREATMENT OF MENTAL, NERVOUS OR EMOTIONAL DISORDERS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4
