- 88 of 1972, on or before October 1, 2005, for the purpose of
- 89 reimbursing the State of Mississippi for administrative costs.

90 SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 91 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 92 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 93 94 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 95 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 96 and after July 1, 2005. 97
