REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1621: Appropriation; Tombigbee River Valley Water Management District.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be

34 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 35 36 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2007 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2006 37 38 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 39 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2007 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 40 41 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 42 43 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 44 act. 45 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2006 appropriation for "Personal 46 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 47 48 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 49 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 50 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2006 "Personal Services" 51 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 52 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 53 54 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 55 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 56

56 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 57 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or

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(H)AP (S)AP A1/2 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 69 70 Tombigbee River Valley Water Management District shall maintain 71 complete accounting and personnel records related to the 72 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such 73 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2005. It is further the intention of 74 75 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee 76 77 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request 78 79 process.

80 SECTION 4. All monies in possession of the district in 81 excess of necessary operating funds shall be deposited with a bank 82 or banks selected by the board of directors of the district. 83 These funds shall be deposited in such bank or banks and in such 84 manner that interest earned shall be at least equal to interest 85 earnings on state funds deposited by the State Treasury.

86 **SECTION 5.** The money herein approved for expenditure shall 87 be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper person, officer 88 or officers, in the manner provided by law.

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89 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 90 and after July 1, 2005.
