Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 38 39 Mississippi Coast Coliseum Commission shall maintain complete 40 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 41 42 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2005. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 43 44 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 45 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 46 provided during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process. 47

SECTION 4. Of the funds provided herein, the sum of One Hundred Sixty Thousand One Hundred Two Dollars (\$160,102.00) is hereby assessed on any non-federal special funds and shall be deposited to the Budget Contingency Fund created in Section 27-103-301, Mississippi Code of 1972, on or before October 1, 2005, for the purpose of reimbursing the State of Mississippi for administrative costs.

55 **SECTION 5.** The money herein approved for expenditure shall 56 be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper person, officer 57 or officers, in the manner provided by law. 58 **SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 59 and after July 1, 2005.
