REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1632: Appropriation; Veterans' Home Purchase Board.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.

2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

6	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be			
7	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State			
8	Treasury to the credit of the Veterans' Home Purchase Board's			
9	revolving fund, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the			
10	Veterans' Home Purchase Board and making new home loans as			
11	authorized by law for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and			
12	ending June 30, 2006\$ 31,907,065.00.			
13	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of			
14	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be			
15	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 33 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 34 35 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 36 Services" for Fiscal Year 2007 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2006 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 37 38 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2007 budget by the 39 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 40 41 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 42 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 43 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 44 45 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2006 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 46 47 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 48 49 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 50 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2006 "Personal Services" 51 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 52 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 53 54 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The

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(H)AP (S)AP A1/2 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification, realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other means to increase salaries of employees or positions, except for the award of teacher pay increases.

73 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Veterans' Home Purchase Board shall maintain complete accounting 74 75 and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the 76 77 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 78 2005. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 79 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 80 81 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 82 during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process.

83 **SECTION 4.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, the sum 84 of Twenty Million Dollars (\$20,000,000.00), or so much thereof as 85 may be available, shall come from the issuance and sale of revenue 86 bonds authorized by Chapter 501, Laws of 1985.

87 SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 88 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 89 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 90 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 91 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 92 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 93 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 94 and after July 1, 2005.
