## MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1636: Appropriation; Real Estate Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise
- 69 award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification,
- 70 realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other
- 71 means to increase salaries of employees or positions, except for
- 72 the award of teacher pay increases.
- 73 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 74 Mississippi Real Estate Appraiser Licensing and Certification
- 75 Board shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records
- 76 related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this
- 77 act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of
- 78 detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2005. It is further the
- 79 intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for
- 80 Fiscal Year 2007 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative
- 81 Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the
- 82 format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2006
- 83 budget request process.
- 84 **SECTION 4.** Of the funds provided herein, the sum of Thirteen
- 85 Thousand Six Hundred Fifty-three Dollars (\$13,653.00) is hereby
- 86 assessed on any non-federal special funds and shall be deposited
- 87 to the Budget Contingency Fund created in Section 27-103-301,
- 88 Mississippi Code of 1972, on or before October 1, 2005, for the
- 89 purpose of reimbursing the State of Mississippi for administrative
- 90 costs.

SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2005.
