We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2006 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

65 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 66 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. 67 The State 68 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 69 70 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 71 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 72 73 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification, realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other means to increase salaries of employees or positions, except for the award of teacher pay increases.

83 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 84 Grand Gulf Military Monument Commission shall maintain complete 85 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 86 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 87 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 88 Year 2005. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 89 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be

(H)AP (S)AP A1/2 90 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 91 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 92 provided during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process.

93 SECTION 5. It shall be unlawful for any officer, employee or 94 other person whatsoever to use or permit or authorize the use of 95 any automobile or any other motor vehicle owned by the State of 96 Mississippi or any department, agency or institution thereof for 97 any purpose other than upon the official business of the State of 98 Mississippi or any agency, department or institution thereof.

99 It is the intent of the Legislature that motor vehicles 100 authorized to be owned and operated by this agency shall comply 101 with Sections 25-1-77 through 25-1-93, Mississippi Code of 1972.

102 SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 103 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 104 105 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 106 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 107 108 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2005. 109
