MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1662: Appropriation; State Fire Academy.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 70 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 71 State Fire Academy shall maintain complete accounting and
- 72 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
- 73 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the
- 74 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year
- 75 2005. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the
- 76 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be submitted to
- 77 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
- 78 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
- 79 during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process.
- 80 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 81 State Fire Academy shall have the authority to escalate and expend
- 82 funds, not to exceed One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars
- 83 (\$150,000.00), from any source that may become available to the
- 84 agency in accordance with the rules and regulations of the
- 85 Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent
- 86 with the escalation of federal funds.
- 87 **SECTION 5.** Of the funds provided herein, the sum of One
- 88 Hundred Eighty-eight Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty-nine Dollars
- 89 (\$188,829.00) is hereby assessed on any non-federal special funds

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90 and shall be deposited to the Budget Contingency Fund created in

91 Section 27-103-301, Mississippi Code of 1972, on or before October

92 1, 2005, for the purpose of reimbursing the State of Mississippi

93 for administrative costs.

94 **SECTION 6.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by

95 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the

96 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon

warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal

Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the

proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

100 **SECTION 7.** This act shall take effect and be in force from

101 and after July 1, 2005.
