REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 2608: Public property; authorize Dept. of Mental Health to sell certain property in Meridian, MS.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 23 SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Finance and 24 Administration, acting on behalf of the Mississippi Department of 25 Mental Health, and upon meeting the requirements of Section 26 29-1-1, may sell and convey all or part of certain state-owned 27 real property located in the City of Meridian, Lauderdale County, 28 commonly known as the Matty Hersee Hospital, more particularly described as follows: 29 30 PARCEL ONE Commencing at the Southwest corner of the Southeast 1/4 31

- 92 (3) The real property described in subsection (1) of this 93 section shall be sold for not less than the current fair market 94 value as determined by the averaging of at least two (2) 95 appraisals by qualified appraisers who shall be selected by the 96 Department of Finance and Administration and shall be certified 97 and licensed by the Mississippi Real Estate Appraiser Licensing 98 and Certification Board.
- 99 (4) Any funds received by the State of Mississippi for the 100 sale and conveyance of the real property described in subsection 101 (1) of this section shall be deposited into the East Mississippi 102 State Hospital Fund, Department of Mental Health.
- 103 (5) The State of Mississippi shall retain all mineral rights 104 to the real property sold and conveyed pursuant to this section.
- SECTION 2. (1) The Department of Finance and

 Administration, acting on behalf of the Mississippi Department of

 Mental Health, may sell to Meridian Community College, on such

 287 and other rehabilitation services;

 292 under any other federal legislation or program having as its
