MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 3064: Appropriation; Information Technology Services.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any special
7	source funds which are collected by or otherwise become available
8	for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi
9	Department of Information Technology Services, for the fiscal year
10	beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006

12	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
13	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
14	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of

AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: 27 28 Permanent: Full Time..... 150 29 Part Time..... 0 30 Time-Limited: Full Time..... 2 31 Part Time..... 32 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 33 34 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2007 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2006 35 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 36 37 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2007 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 38 39 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 40 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 41 42 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 43 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 44 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2006 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 45 46 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services, " the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 47 48 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2006 "Personal Services" 49 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 50 51 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 52 53 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 54 55 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 56 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 57 58 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration.

- 59 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 60 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 61 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 62 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 64 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 65 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 66 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise
- 68 award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification,
- 69 realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other
- 70 means to increase salaries of employees or positions, except for
- 71 the award of teacher pay increases.
- 72 **SECTION 3.** In order to offset the cost of publishing the
- 73 annual Mississippi Official Telephone Directory, the Mississippi
- 74 Department of Information Technology Services is hereby
- 75 authorized, empowered and directed, in its discretion, to offer
- 76 for advertising purposes, pages to be included in said Directory,
- 77 to accept bids, and to let contracts for said pages. The
- 78 contracts for said advertising purposes shall be let for definite
- 79 periods not to exceed two (2) years.
- 80 It shall be the duty of the Mississippi Department of
- 81 Information Technology Services, if it is desired that advertising
- 82 shall be used, to approve all proposed advertising submitted for
- 83 use within such annual Mississippi Official Telephone Directory.
- 84 The department is hereby authorized, empowered and directed, in
- 85 its discretion, to reject any and all bids submitted, and if all
- 86 bids are rejected, the authority may negotiate a contract within
- 87 the limitations of the specifications so long as the terms of any
- 88 such negotiated contract are equal to or better than the
- 89 comparable terms submitted by the lowest and best bidder. No
- 90 sectarian, un-American, political, partisan or immoral

- 91 advertisement, as determined solely by the authority or its
- 92 successor, shall be accepted.
- All monies derived from sale of such advertising shall be 93
- 94 deposited in the appropriate special fund in the State Treasury to
- 95 the credit of the Mississippi Department of Information Technology
- 96 Services.
- 97 SECTION 4. The Mississippi Department of Information
- Technology Services is hereby authorized to receive additional 98
- 99 funds from any state agency or other source, including one hundred
- 100 percent (100%) general-fund agencies, for the purpose of providing
- 101 data processing or telecommunications services to any governmental
- organization contracting with the Mississippi Department of 102
- 103 Information Technology Services for such services.
- 104 Mississippi Department of Information Technology Services is
- 105 further authorized to escalate an amount not to exceed One Million
- 106 Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) and to increase, up to a maximum of twenty
- 107 (20) additional positions, the number of authorized positions
- 108 listed in this act in order to provide the required data
- processing or telecommunications services for such governmental 109
- 110 organizations, under the rules and regulations of the Department
- of Finance and Administration. 111
- 112 SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
- Section 1, One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) is 113
- 114 authorized for expenditure and for the established purpose of
- 115 E-Government Special Fund 3602.
- SECTION 6. None of the funds herein appropriated shall be 116
- 117 expended by Information Technology Services unless assessments,
- fees or rate levels charged to other state agencies for services 118

- 120 for the establishment of rates for a new or expanded service, and
- 121 required increases due to costs not within the control of this

123	SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
124	Department of Information Technology Services shall maintain
125	complete accounting and personnel records related to the
126	expenditure of all funds appropriated under the provisions of this
127	act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of
128	details as maintained for Fiscal Year 2005. It is further the
129	intention of the Legislature that the budget request for Fiscal
130	Year 2007 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget
131	Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format
132	and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget
133	request process.
134	SECTION 8. Of the funds provided herein, the sum of One
135	Million Five Hundred Thirteen Thousand Three Hundred Thirty-seven
136	Dollars (\$1,513,337.00) is hereby assessed on any non-federal
137	special funds and shall be deposited to the Budget Contingency
138	Fund created in Section 27-103-301, Mississippi Code of 1972, on
139	or before October 1, 2005, for the purpose of reimbursing the
140	State of Mississippi for administrative costs.
141	SECTION 9. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
142	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
143	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
144	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
145	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
146	proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
147	SECTION 10. This act shall take effect and be in force from
148	and after July 1, 2005.
