MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

- S. B. No. 3089: Appropriation; Board of Massage Therapy.
 - We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:
 - 1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
 - 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
- 6 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
- 7 Treasury to the credit of the State Board of Massage Therapy Fund,
- 8 for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi State
- 9 Board of Massage Therapy for the fiscal year beginning
- 10 July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006.....\$ 103,861.00.
- 11 SECTION 2. Of the funds provided herein, the sum of Three
- 12 Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty-one Dollars (\$3,861.00) is hereby
- 13 assessed on any non-federal special funds and shall be deposited
- 14 to the Budget Contingency Fund created in Section 27-103-301,
- 15 Mississippi Code of 1972, on or before October 1, 2005, for the
- 16 purpose of reimbursing the State of Mississippi for administrative
- 17 costs.
- 18 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 19 Board of Massage Therapy shall maintain complete accounting and
- 20 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
- 21 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the
- 22 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year
- 23 2005. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the
- 24 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be submitted to
- 25 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of

- detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 26
- during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process. 27
- SECTION 4. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 28
- the State Treasurer out of any money in the proper fund or funds 29
- 30 as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal
- Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants 31
- upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers 32
- in the manner provided by law. 33
- SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from 34
