

**REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE**

**# 2**

**MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:**

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 3089: Appropriation; Board of Massage Therapy.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

**Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:**

5           **SECTION 1.** The following sum, or so much thereof as may be  
6 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State  
7 Treasury to the credit of the State Board of Massage Therapy Fund,  
8 for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi State  
9 Board of Massage Therapy for the fiscal year beginning  
10 July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006.....\$ 103,861.00.

11           **SECTION 2.** Of the funds provided herein, the sum of Three  
12 Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty-one Dollars (\$3,861.00) is hereby  
13 assessed on any non-federal special funds and shall be deposited  
14 to the Budget Contingency Fund created in Section 27-103-301,  
15 Mississippi Code of 1972, on or before October 1, 2005, for the  
16 purpose of reimbursing the State of Mississippi for administrative  
17 costs.

18           **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the  
19 Board of Massage Therapy shall maintain complete accounting and  
20 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds  
21 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the  
22 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year  
23 2005. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the  
24 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be submitted to  
25 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of

26 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided  
27 during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process.

28       **SECTION 4.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by  
29 the State Treasurer out of any money in the proper fund or funds  
30 as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal  
31 Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants  
32 upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers  
33 in the manner provided by law.

34       **SECTION 5.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
35 and after July 1, 2005.
