We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as
6	may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the
7	State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Motor Vehicle
8	Commission, as provided by Section 63-17-51 et seq., Mississippi
9	Code of 1972, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of said
10	Commission, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending
11	June 30, 2006\$ 246,457.00.
12	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
13	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
14	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
15	expenditure:

32	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
33	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
34	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
35	Services" for Fiscal Year 2007 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2006
36	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
37	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2007 budget by the
38	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
39	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
40	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
41	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
42	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
43	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
44	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2006 appropriation for "Personal
45	Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
46	If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
47	Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
48	has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
49	projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2006 "Personal Services"
50	appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
51	reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
52	requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
53	such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
54	Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
55	the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
56	allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
57	Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
58	approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The

- 59 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 60 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 61 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 62 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 64 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 65 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 66 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise
- 68 award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification,
- 69 realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other
- 70 means to increase salaries of employees or positions, except for
- 71 the award of teacher pay increases.
- 72 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that none
- 73 of the funds appropriated under the provisions of this act shall
- 74 be expended to defray any expenses of the Motor Vehicle Commission
- 75 if said commission takes any official actions during Fiscal Year
- 76 2006 that serve directly or indirectly to reduce the payment to
- 77 the State General Fund of any sales tax on motor vehicles sold
- 78 within the State of Mississippi.
- 79 It is further the intention of the Legislature that if such
- 80 actions are taken by the Motor Vehicle Commission during Fiscal
- 81 Year 2006, the executive director and commission members shall be
- 82 held personally liable for repayment of any funds expended under
- 83 the provisions of this act with said repayment to be made to the
- 84 State General Fund. The Attorney General is hereby authorized and
- 85 directed to undertake appropriate legal action to enforce the
- 86 provisions of this act and to recover said funds.
- 87 **SECTION 4.** Of the funds provided herein, the sum of Eleven
- 88 Thousand Six Hundred Ninety-three Dollars (\$11,693.00) is hereby
- 89 assessed on any non-federal special funds and shall be deposited
- 90 to the Budget Contingency Fund created in Section 27-103-301,

Mississippi Code of 1972, on or before October 1, 2005, for the 91

purpose of reimbursing the State of Mississippi for administrative 92

93 costs.

94 SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by

95 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the

credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 96

97 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal

Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the

proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 99

SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 100

101 and after July 1, 2005.
