MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 3096: Appropriation; Veterinary Exam. Bd.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** That the following sum, or so much thereof as may
- 6 be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
- 7 Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi State Board of
- 8 Veterinary Examiners for the purpose of defraying the expenses
- 9 incurred by said board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005,
- 10 and ending June 30, 2006.....\$ 118,475.00.
- 11 SECTION 2. Any transfers or escalations shall be made in
- 12 accordance with the terms, conditions, and procedures established
- 13 by law.
- 14 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 15 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 16 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 17 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 18 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 19 Mississippi State Board of Veterinary Examiners is hereby
- 20 authorized to accept, budget, and expend funds, not to exceed
- 21 Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) from any source in accordance
- 22 with the rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and
- 23 Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of
- 24 federal funds.
- 25 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 26 Veterinary Examiners Board shall maintain complete accounting and

- 27 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
- 28 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the
- 29 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year
- 30 2005. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the
- 31 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be submitted to
- 32 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
- 33 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
- 34 during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process.
- 35 **SECTION 5.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 36 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 37 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 38 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 39 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 40 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
- 41 **SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 42 and after July 1, 2005.
