## House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 2647

## TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

39 SECTION 1. (2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized 55 56 by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms prescribed by the State Tax Commission. The application and the 57 58 additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less 59 Two Dollars (\$2.00) thereof to be retained by the tax collector, shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis 60 as prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional 61 fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the 62
