House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 2699

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 7 SECTION 1. Section 49-7-33, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 8 amended as follows:
- (1) It is unlawful to hunt, trap or kill any wild 9 49-7-33.
- bird or wild animal of any kind with the aid of bait, recordings 10
- of bird or animal calls, or electrically amplified imitations of 11
- 12 calls of any kind, except a person:
- 13 (a) May use electrically amplified sound devices for
- hunting coyote and crow; 14
- 15 (b) May use liquid scents for any animal or bird; and
- 16 (c) May use lures for trapping furbearing animals,
- 17 beaver, coyote, fox and nutria according to regulations adopted by
- 18 the commission.
- The commission, in its discretion, may relax the 19
- 20 restrictions regarding the use of lures or sound devices if a
- 21 condition arises or exists, as decided by the State Board of
- Health or county board of health, that may endanger persons or 22
- livestock in a certain community, county or area. 23
- 24
- 25 (3) A person may use bait to trap wild hogs as defined in
- 26 Section 49-7-140 during the period between the end of Spring
- 27 turkey season and the beginning of deer season with bow and arrow.
- Pen traps shall not be taller than six (6) feet and shall be open 28
- over the top the same dimensions as the pen walls. 29
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 30
- 31 and after July 1, 2005.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-7-33, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO ALLOW THE USE OF LURES TO TRAP FURBEARING ANIMALS, BEAVER, COYOTE, FOX AND NUTRIA; TO ALLOW THE USE OF BAIT TO TRAP WILD HOGS WHEN THERE IS NO OPEN HUNTING SEASON FOR TURKEY OR DEER; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
