House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 2931

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 9 There is established the Mississippi **SECTION 1.** (1)
- 10 Disability Resource Commission. The function of the commission is
- 11 to:
- 12 (a) Assimilate and provide current information to
- persons who need health, special education or disability 13

- 15 Refer those persons to the appropriate agencies to

- special education or disability services; 19
- 20 Be a comprehensive clearinghouse of information and
- 21 single point of contact for people with disabilities related to
- 22 potential service programs; and
- 23 (e) Otherwise assist persons who need health, special
- 24 education or disability services in obtaining information and
- 2.5 services.
- The powers and duties of the Mississippi Disability 26 (2)
- Resource Commission shall include, but are not limited to, or 27
- 28 provided in any priority order, the following:
- 29 To collect and analyze health, special education
- and disability-related data for use by state agencies, 30
- 31 universities and colleges, organizations and private citizens;
- 32 (b) To advise the Governor, the Legislature, the
- 33 Mississippi congressional delegation, state agencies, the business
- 34 community, other public and private groups and the general public

- on health, special education and disability issues and concerns, 35
- 36 and to make recommendations to address those identified matters,
- with emphasis on increasing opportunities for independence and 37
- 38 employment;
- To coordinate and conduct public relations 39 (C)
- 40 activities, including establishment of a permanent, statewide
- toll-free phone line for people with disabilities seeking access 41
- 42 to services and programs, to promote the skills and capabilities
- 43 of persons needing health, special education or disability
- 44 services; and
- 45 (d) To submit an annual report to the Governor and to
- the Legislature with recommendations to address the needs of 46
- 47 persons in Mississippi needing health, special education or
- disability services, and other pertinent data regarding health, 48
- 49 special education or disability issues.
- 50 The membership of the commission shall consist of
- thirteen (13) members as follows: 51
- 52 (a) The Executive Director of the State Department of
- 53 Rehabilitation Services, or his or her designee;
- The Executive Director of the State Department of 54 (b)
- Mental Health, or his or her designee; 55
- 56 (C) The Executive Officer of the State Department of
- 57 Health, or his or her designee;
- 58 The State Superintendent of Public Education, or
- 59 his or her designee;
- The Executive Director of the Division of Medicaid, 60
- 61 or his or her designee;
- The Executive Director of the Department of Human 62 (f)
- 63 Services, or his or her designee; and
- 64 Three (3) appointments by the Governor and two (2)
- appointments each by the Lieutenant Governor and Speaker of the 65
- 66 House of Representatives.
- 67 Each of the appointments referenced in paragraph (g) of this
- 68 subsection shall be a person with a disability, a representative
- 69 of a disability advocacy group, or the parent of a person with a

70 disability. Of these appointments, there shall be no more than

71 one (1) appointment from the same consumer organization or

- advocacy group during the same term of appointment. 72
- 73 (4) Members appointed by the Governor, Lieutenant Governor
- 74 and Speaker of the House shall serve for terms that run
- 75 concurrently with the terms of office of the appointing officials.
- 76 An appointment to fill a vacancy, other than by expiration of a
- 77 term of office, shall be made for the balance of the unexpired
- 78 term.
- 79 (5) The members of the commission shall elect from their
- 80 membership the chairperson and vice chairperson of the commission.
- 81 The chairperson and vice chairperson shall be a member appointed
- 82 under subsection (3)(g) of this section and a member from a state
- agency referenced in subsection (3)(a) through (f) of this 83
- 84 section. The chairperson and vice chairperson shall serve for
- 85 terms of one (1) year beginning on July 1 of each year, except
- that the terms of the first chairperson and vice chairperson shall 86
- 87 begin on the date of their election to those positions.
- 88 year at the expiration of the terms of the chairperson and vice
- 89 chairperson, the vice chairperson during the preceding year shall
- 90 serve as chairperson for the next year, and a new vice chairperson
- 91 shall be elected according to the terms set forth in this
- 92 subsection.
- 93 The commission shall meet at least quarterly and hold
- 94 other meetings as are necessary for the purpose of conducting
- required business, not exceeding six (6) meetings in any one (1) 95
- fiscal year. If funds are available for that purpose, the 96
- appointed members of the commission may be paid per diem and 97
- 98 travel expenses in accordance with the provisions of Sections
- 99 25-3-69 and 25-3-41.
- (7) The Mississippi Disability Resource Commission may 100
- 101 receive and expend any monies appropriated by the Legislature,
- 102 apply for and utilize grants, and receive gifts or any other
- 103 appropriate source of funds to carry out the duties of office.

104 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 105 and after its passage.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE MISSISSIPPI DISABILITY RESOURCE
COMMISSION TO ASSIMILATE AND PROVIDE CURRENT INFORMATION, REFER
PERSONS TO APPROPRIATE AGENCIES, FACILITATE COORDINATION OF AGENCY
SERVICES, AND BE A COMPREHENSIVE INFORMATION CLEARINGHOUSE AND
SINGLE POINT OF CONTACT FOR PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES; TO PRESCRIBE
THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE COMMISSION AND PRESCRIBE ITS POWERS AND
DUTIES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
