House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 3058

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

The following sums of money, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of the proceeds 22 from any federal, student fees or other special source funds not 23 otherwise appropriated, to the Board of Trustees of State 24 Institutions of Higher Learning for the purpose of support of 25 26 Mississippi State Chemical Laboratory, Water Resources Institute, 27 Mississippi Alcohol Safety Education Program, Stennis Institute of Government, Mississippi Law Research Institute, Mississippi Small 28 29 Business Development Center, Mississippi Mineral Resources Research Institute, Research Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences, 30 31 the Supercomputer, Stennis Space Center's Center for Higher 32 Learning, Gulf Coast Research Laboratory, Polymer Institute,

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Jackson State University Urban Research Center, the Commission for 33 34 Volunteer Services and the executive office of the board of trustees for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending 35 36 June 30, 2006..... \$ 49,272,848.00. 101	Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 1,
102	and allocated to the Gulf Coast Research Laboratory, the Board of
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103 Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning shall allocate 104 for Sea Grants matching One Hundred Seventy-five Thousand Dollars 105 (\$175,000.00) for the Fiscal Year 2006.

106 Provided further, it is the intention of the Legislature, in 107 the event budget reductions are imposed on the Gulf Coast Research 108 Laboratory by the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning, as a result of the Governor ordering budget 109 reductions under the provisions of Section 27-104-13 or 31-17-123, 110 111 Mississippi Code of 1972, the same percent reduction will be applied to those state funds identified in this section for Sea 112 113 Grant match.

It is the intent of the Legislature that no general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

After the Mississippi State Chemical Laboratory has provided 119 120 the maximum amount of services which may be provided free of 121 charge under the provisions of Section 57-21-11(c), Mississippi Code of 1972, the laboratory shall not provide any additional 122 123 services from the funds appropriated under the provisions of 124 Sections 1 and 2 if any charges for such services previously 125 provided are more than ninety (90) days past due. After all such 126 delinquent charges have been paid by a client, the laboratory may 127 provide additional services to the client.

SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2 and authorized for expenditure in Section 4(2), the following amounts shall be derived from Education Enhancement Funds deposited pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 132 1972:

SECTION 6. None of the funds appropriated by this act shall
be expended for any purpose that is not actually required or
necessary for performing any of the powers or duties of the Board
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of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning, or any of the powers or duties of any institution under the jurisdiction of the board of trustees, that are authorized by the Mississippi Constitution of 1890, state or federal law, or rules or regulations that implement state or federal law.

143 SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 144 budget requests of the individual institutes, laboratories and 145 programs consolidated in this bill for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be 146 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 147 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 148 provided during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process.

SECTION 8. The Board of Trustees shall report yearly to the
Legislature the institution compliance with Section 97-11-51,
Mississippi Code of 1972, which prohibits deficit spending.

152 **SECTION 9.** Any funds appropriated pursuant to this act and 153 paid as a fee to or deposited in a financial institution shall be 154 in compliance with Section 109 of the Constitution of the State of 155 Mississippi and Section 25-4-103, Mississippi Code of 1972.

SECTION 10. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 156 157 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 158 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 159 160 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 161 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 162 SECTION 11. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2005. 163
