House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 3074

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

32 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 33 34 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2007 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2006 35 36 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 37 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2007 budget by the 38 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 39 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 40 41 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 42 act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 43 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2006 appropriation for "Personal 44 45 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 46 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 47 48 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 49 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2006 "Personal Services" 50 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 51 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 52 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 53 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

54 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 55 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 56 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 57 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 58 The 59 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 60 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 61 appropriated level. 62

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall beused to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are

65 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 66 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

67 SECTION 3. This appropriation is made for the purpose of 68 providing funds to defray the expenses of the Mississippi 69 Institute for Forest Inventory as established in Section 70 49-19-403, Mississippi Code of 1972.

SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi Institute for Forest Inventory is hereby authorized to accept, budget and expend funds, not to exceed One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00), from any source in accordance with rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.

83 **SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 84 and after July 1, 2005.
