House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 3095

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	Treasury to the credit of the Office of State Aid Road
8	Construction Fund, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of
9	the Office of State Aid Road Construction of the Mississippi
10	Department of Transportation for the fiscal year beginning
11	July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006 \$ 118,458,365.00.
12	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
13	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
14	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of

31 AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: 32 Full Time..... 42 Permanent: 33 Part Time..... 1 Full Time..... 34 Time-Limited: 35 Part Time..... With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 36 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 37 38 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 39 Services" for Fiscal Year 2007 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2006 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 40 41 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2007 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 42 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 43 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 44 45 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 46 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 47 48 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2006 appropriation for "Personal 49 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 50 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 51 Services, " the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 52 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 53 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2006 "Personal Services" 54 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 55 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 56 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 57 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 58 59 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 60 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 61 62 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 63 64 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions

65 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 66 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the

Office of State Aid Road Construction shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2005. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process.

SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Office of State Aid Road Construction shall have the authority to accept, budget and expend funds, comprised of special funds to the office, not to exceed Thirty-five Million Dollars (\$35,000,000.00) for the purpose of replacement of structurally deficient bridges on the state's county roads. Such funds are to be escalated in accordance with procedures for federal fund escalations as established in Section 27-104-21, Mississippi Code of 1972, and expended for the purposes of performing such duties as set forth by law in accordance with applicable rules and regulations of the State Fiscal Officer.

SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that none of the funds appropriated above shall be expended unless members of the Mississippi House of Representatives and Mississippi Senate are notified at least five (5) days prior to a public ceremony announcing the award of any grant in their district or any public announcement or ceremony regarding the groundbreaking or opening of a facility, roadway or bridge for which the Legislature has made funds available. Any signage regarding any public event or

100 any new facility, roadway or bridge shall include the following

101 language: "Funds were made available for this project by the

102 Mississippi State Legislature."

103 **SECTION 6.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by

104 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the

105 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon

106 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal

Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the

proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.

109 **SECTION 7.** This act shall take effect and be in force from

110 and after July 1, 2005.
