- 26 three (3) years; a certified wildlife or fisheries biologist, two
- 27 (2) years; and a representative of an environmental organization
- 28 one (1) year. After the expiration of the initial terms, the terms
- 29 shall be for four (4) years.
- 30 (c) The Lieutenant Governor shall appoint three (3)
- 31 members from the state at large with the advice and consent of the
- 32 Senate. The Lieutenant Governor shall appoint one (1) member from
- 33 each of the following categories: the timber harvesting industry,
- 34 the forest products industry, and a citizen with forestry related
- 35 interests. Appointments made after January 1, 2005, shall be for
- 36 initial terms as follows: timber harvesting industry, four (4)
- 37 years; forest products industry, three (3) years; and a citizen

- (e) The Chairman of the Senate Forestry Committee and
- 45 the Chairman of the House Forestry Committee shall serve as
- 46 members of the Joint Institute for Forest Inventory Oversight
- 47 Committee. For attending meetings, the legislators shall receive
- 48 per diem and expenses from their respective contingent expense

- (e) To do all acts necessary to carry out the duties of

- 68 (4) All funds received by the institute shall be deposited
- 69 in the State Treasury for the use of the institute.
