COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO**

Senate Bill No. 2699

**Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting
in lieu thereof the following:**

7 **SECTION 1.** Section 49-7-33, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
8 amended as follows:

9 49-7-33. (1) It is unlawful to hunt, trap or kill any wild
10 bird or wild animal of any kind with the aid of bait, recordings
11 of bird or animal calls, or electrically amplified imitations of
12 calls of any kind, except a person:

13 (a) May use electrically amplified sound devices for
14 hunting coyote and crow;

15 (b) May use liquid scents for any animal or bird; and

16 (c) May use lures for trapping furbearing animals,
17 beaver, coyote, fox and nutria according to regulations adopted by
18 the commission.

19 (2) The commission, in its discretion, may relax the
20 restrictions regarding the use of lures or sound devices if a
21 condition arises or exists, as decided by the State Board of
22 Health or county board of health, that may endanger persons or
23 livestock in a certain community, county or area.

25 (3) A person may use bait to trap wild hogs as defined in
26 Section 49-7-140 during the period between the end of Spring
27 turkey season and the beginning of deer season with bow and arrow.

28 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
29 and after July 1, 2005.

**Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and
inserting in lieu thereof the following:**

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-7-33, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
2 ALLOW THE USE OF LURES TO TRAP FURBEARING ANIMALS, BEAVER, COYOTE,
3 FOX AND NUTRIA; TO ALLOW THE USE OF BAIT TO TRAP WILD HOGS WHEN
4 THERE IS NO OPEN HUNTING SEASON FOR TURKEY OR DEER; AND FOR
5 RELATED PURPOSES.
