Adopted COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO

Senate Bill No. 2731

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

(1) There is created a commission to study the 6 SECTION 1. 7 effectiveness and efficiency of the Mississippi Adequate Education 8 Program (MAEP) in providing adequacy and equity in public school 9 funding. The commission shall, at a minimum, study and report on the following factors related to MAEP: 10 (a) Efficiency; 11 Selection of school districts for funding 12 (b) calculations; 13 High growth districts; 14 (C) State and local contributions; and 15 (d) 16 (e) Add on programs. The State Board of Education shall contract with a consulting firm 17 that has expertise in public school funding formulas to assist the 18 19 commission with the study. The commission shall make a report of its findings and recommendations to the Legislature by November 1, 20 21 2005, including any recommended legislation.

(2) The commission shall be composed of the following ten

(10) members:

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- The Chairman of the House and Senate Education 24 (a)
- 25 Committees;
- The Chairman of the House and Senate Appropriation 26 (b)
- 27 Committees;
- 28 (C) Three (3) representatives to be appointed by the
- 29 Speaker of the House; and
- Three (3) senators to be appointed by the 30
- 31 Lieutenant Governor.
- Appointments shall be made within thirty (30) days after 32
- the effective date of this act. The commission shall hold its 33
- 34 first meeting before August 1, 2005. The Chairman of the House
- Education Committee and the Chairman of the Senate Education 35
- 36 Committee shall serve as cochairmen of the commission.
- 37 Members of the commission may not be compensated for the (4)
- performance of their duties. Any incidental costs associated with 38
- conducting the study shall be paid by the State Department of 39
