Based on data provided by the 48 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 49 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 50 51 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure

53 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 54 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2006 appropriation for "Personal

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Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 55 56 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 57 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 58 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 59 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2006 "Personal Services" 60 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 61 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 62 63 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

64 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 65 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 66 67 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 68 The 69 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 70 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 71 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 72 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 112 113 Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Prepaid Affordable College Tuition Trust Fund for the purpose of paying all amounts 114 due for prepaid tuition contracts of the Mississippi Prepaid 115 116 Affordable College Tuition Program, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006..... \$ 15,500,000.00.

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It is the intention of the Legislature that the State 118 119 Treasurer is hereby authorized to accept, budget and expend an amount not to exceed One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) from any 120 121 funds authorized for the Mississippi Prepaid Affordable College 122 Tuition Program, for paying amounts due for prepaid tuition contracts of the Mississippi Prepaid Affordable College Tuition 123 124 Program. Such funds shall be escalated in accordance with the 125 rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of 126 127 federal funds.

**SECTION 8.** The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the Health Care Expendable Fund, created under House Bill No. 519, 1999 Regular Session, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Office of the State Treasurer for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending

SECTION 12. No part of the funds appropriated herein shall 181 182 be used in the payment of attorney's fees, nor shall any of said funds be used either directly or indirectly, for the purpose of 183 184 paying any clerk, stenographer, assistant, deputy or other person 185 who may be related by blood or marriage within the third degree, 186 computed by the rules of the civil law, to the official employing 187 or having the right of employment or selection thereof; and in the 188 event of any such payment, then the official or person approving 189 and making or receiving such payment shall be jointly and severally liable to return to the State of Mississippi and to pay 190 191 into the State Treasury three (3) times any such amount so paid or 192 received, to be recovered at suit of the Attorney General; 193 provided that when the relationship is by affinity and the person 194 through whom the relationship was established is dead, this 195 provision shall not apply.

196 SECTION 13. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Office of the State Treasurer shall maintain complete accounting 197 198 and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds 199 appropriated under the provisions of this act and that such 200 records shall be in the same format and level of details as 201 maintained for Fiscal Year 2005. It is further the intention of 202 the Legislature that the budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall 203 be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 204 205 provided during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process.

206 **SECTION 14.** None of the above funds shall be used to fund 207 any expenditures for litigation against the Partnership for a 208 Healthy Mississippi.

SECTION 15. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal

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Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. **SECTION 16.** This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2005.
