461	SECTION 7. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of

463	Sections 2 and 3, and allocated under the provisions of Section 4,
464	funds in the amount of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00)
465	may be expended for the support of a pilot project to provide
466	authority for East Mississippi State Hospital and Mississippi
467	State Hospital to contract with local hospitals located in
468	counties with a population of less than fifty thousand (50,000) to
469	provide emergency inpatient care to individuals committed by the
470	Chancery Court to East Mississippi State Hospital or Mississippi
471	State Hospital for treatment of mental illness if, at the time

that such commitment is made, a bed is not available for admission 472 473 to East Mississippi State Hospital or Mississippi State Hospital. 474 East Mississippi State Hospital and Mississippi State Hospital 475 shall have the authority to contract with local hospitals located 476 in counties with a population of less than fifty thousand (50,000) 477 for inpatient emergency care for a period not to exceed seven (7) days at a rate not to exceed One Hundred and Fifty Dollars 478 479 (\$150.00) per day with East Mississippi State Hospital or 480 Mississippi State Hospital providing One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) 481 and the local government providing Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per day 482 for such care. Payment for such physician fees shall be made at 483 the Medicaid rate of reimbursement and paid by East Mississippi 484 State Hospital or Mississippi State Hospital. Funds provided for 485 the initiation of this pilot project shall not be expended for inpatient hospital care unless there is participation in the 486 487 reimbursement for such care by the local government as required by the provisions of this section. 488 489 SECTION 8. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 490 Executive Director of the Department of Mental Health shall have 491 authority to transfer cash from one special fund treasury fund to 492 another special fund treasury fund under the control of the 493 Department of Mental Health. The purpose of this authority is to 494 more efficiently use available cash reserves. It is further the 495 intention of the Legislature that the Executive Director of the 496 Department of Mental Health shall submit written justification for 497 the transfer to the Legislative Budget Office and the Department 498 of Finance and Administration on or before the fifteenth (15th) of 499 the month prior to the effective date of the transfer. 500 SECTION 9. The Executive Director of the Department of 501 Mental Health and the directors of each separate facility operated 502 by the Department of Mental Health are hereby authorized to

transfer spending authority from any major objects to any other

- major objects in any amounts deemed necessary for the efficient
 management and operation of their budgets, provided that the total
 spending authority remains unchanged after such transfers and the
 total of such transfers into any major object do not exceed
 twenty-five percent (25%) of the original appropriated amount for
 that major object plus any escalations of spending authority that
 have occurred during any given fiscal year.
- SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 511 Department of Mental Health shall have the authority to receive, 512 budget, and expend funds from any source, including beginning cash 513 514 in excess of beginning cash when spending authority was initially appropriated, that may become available to the department in 515 516 accordance with the rules and regulations of the Department of 517 Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds. 518
- SECTION 11. The Department of Mental Health and its 519 facilities shall have the authority, within funding and spending 520 521 authority appropriated under the provisions of Section 1, authorized for expenditure in Sections 2 and 3, and allocated 522 523 under the provisions of Section 4 of this act, to transfer funds 524 to the Division of Medicaid in payment of Medicaid match and 525 designate that the funds thus transferred shall be applied to 526 Medicaid match obligations arising in the subsequent fiscal year.
- SECTION 12. Any person within the Department of Mental
 Health who must work on a statutory holiday or any holiday

 proclaimed by the Governor, may at the discretion of the Director
 of the Institution and the Executive Director of the Department of
 Mental Health and within available personnel funds, be paid "call
 back pay" in lieu of "compensatory time credit."
- 533 **SECTION 13.** Of the funds appropriated to the "Service 534 Budget" in the category "Subsidies, Loans and Grants," funds are

535 included for the support of community mental health services for 536 Fiscal Year 2006.

Provided, however, that none of the funds appropriated for 537 538 the support of community mental health services shall be made 539 available to any Regional Mental Health/Retardation Center which 540 does not receive from each of its participating counties a dollar 541 amount equivalent to what the proceeds of a three-fourths (3/4) 542 mill tax on all taxable property in the county in Fiscal Year 1982 would have been or the amount of funds contributed to the center 543 by the county in Fiscal Year 1984, whichever shall be greater. By 544 545 means of performance contracts, the Department of Mental Health 546 shall disburse the funds appropriated in this section for services 547 for the mentally ill, mentally retarded and alcohol/drug abusers. 548 The State Board of Mental Health and the Department of Mental 549 Health shall be responsible for selecting the types of services which shall be provided with the funds appropriated in this 550 551 section, for developing and monitoring performance contracts and 552 for holding contractors accountable for utilization of funds. 553 SECTION 14. Funds presently included or any funds received 554 in the future for timber funds at Ellisville State School and East 555 Mississippi State Hospital are hereby authorized for transfer to 556 the regular operating budgets of the respective facilities. Each 557 facility shall receive such funds as "Special" funds, and such funds shall be available for use in payment of any and all 558 559 expenses of each facility, paid by the State Treasurer upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 560 561 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 562 SECTION 15. The Department of Mental Health and its 563 564 facilities shall have the express legal authority, within funding

and spending authority appropriated under the provisions of

Section 1, authorized for expenditure under the provisions of

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Sections 2 and 3, and allocated under the provisions of Section 4 567 568 of this act, to purchase land for use by residential facilities operated by the Department, either directly or by means of 569 570 transferring funds to the Bureau of Building, Grounds and Real 571 Property Management, and to transfer such funds to Bureau of 572 Building, Grounds, and Real Property Management for the purposes 573 of constructing and equipping group homes for persons with mental 574 illness, mental retardation, and/or substance abuse; constructing and equipping such other buildings as may be required for 575 576 treatment of persons with mental illness, mental retardation, 577 and/or substance abuse; repair and renovate existing buildings; and to construct, repair and/or renovate employee housing. Any 578 579 intermediate care facilities for the mentally retarded (ICF/MR) 580 constructed with funds authorized in this section shall be authorized to participate in Medicaid funding available for such 581 582 services. SECTION 16. Of the General Funds appropriated to the 583 584 "Service Budget" in the category of "Subsidies, Loans and Grants," 585 the sum required may be expended to fund the Home and Community 586 Based Waiver Option for community mental retardation services as 587 authorized under Section 43-13-117(29) of the Mississippi Code of 588 1972 (Annotated). 589 SECTION 17. With the funds herein appropriated, the Department of Mental Health is authorized to provide home and 590 591 community based treatment and institutional treatment to not more than ten (10) persons at any given time who, on or after reaching 592 593 their twenty-first birthday (age 21), suffered a severe brain 594 injury and whose condition as a result of that brain injury would 595 have resulted in their classification as developmentally disabled 596 if such injury had occurred prior to their twenty-first birthday.
