## AMENDMENT NO. 1

## Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

7 15-1-3. (1) The completion of the period of limitation 8 prescribed to bar any action, shall defeat and extinguish the 9 right as well as the remedy. However, the former legal obligation 10 shall be a sufficient consideration to uphold a new promise based 11 thereon.

## 12 (2) In any case founded on a debt, when any part of the debt

13 shall have been paid, or an acknowledgment of an existing

14 liability, debt or claim, or any promise to pay the same shall

15 have been made, the statute of limitations not having run, an

16 action may be brought in such case within the period prescribed

17 for the same, with the said period to begin after such payment,

18 acknowledgment or promise.

19 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 20 and after July 1, 2005.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
