## Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 772

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5 SECTION 1. Section 73-3-123, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 amended as follows:

7 73-3-123. (1) Each member of the bar shall, unless exempt by virtue of Section 73-3-125, pay enrollment fees each year in an 8 amount as established by the Board of Commissioners, but not to 9 exceed the sum of Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00) \* \* \* for those 10 11 members admitted to practice law for three (3) years or more; and Two Hundred Sixty Dollars (\$260.00) for those members admitted to 12 practice law for one (1) year, but less than three (3) years; and 13 14 Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for those members admitted to practice law less than one (1) year; and Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) 15 for those members on inactive status. All enrollment fees shall 16 17 be paid for the same period, that is, for the period of one (1) year beginning on the day and month to be determined as provided 18 19 in Section 73-3-127. The enrollment fees shall be paid to the 20 secretary of the bar.

(2) The Board of Bar Commissioners shall increase enrollment
fees within the limitations imposed by subsection (1) of this
section by not more than the minimum increment necessary to cover
the annual expenses of The Mississippi Bar.

25 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 26 and after July 1, 2005.
