## Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1418

## TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 7 **SECTION 1.** Section 49-7-38, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 8 amended as follows:
- 9 49-7-38. (1) (a) The commission may issue a special
- 10 license to hunt deer, turkey and small game with a crossbow to any
- 11 person sixty-five (65) years of age or older or to any person
- 12 having a disability which totally and permanently prevents the
- 13 person from using a longbow or other conventional archery
- 14 equipment as first certified by one (1) physician duly licensed to
- 15 practice medicine in the state. The commission shall designate
- 16 the fee for the license. The commission shall set the crossbow
- 17 season for small game. A special licensee under this section may
- 18 take deer or turkey with a crossbow during the respective seasons
- 19 on deer and turkey.
- 20 (b) The commission may issue a crossbow permit to hunt
- 21 with a crossbow during the open seasons on deer with guns and
- 22 primitive weapons. A person required to have a hunting license
- 23 must have a license to take deer and turkey in order to obtain a
- 24 crossbow permit. The commission shall establish a fee for the
- 25 permit.
- 26 (2) This section shall stand repealed from and after July 1,
- 27 2008.
- 28 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 29 and after its passage.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-7-38, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO ALLOW THE USE OF A CROSSBOW TO HUNT DURING CERTAIN OPEN SEASONS ON DEER; TO AUTHORIZE THE COMMISSION ON WILDLIFE, FISHERIES AND PARKS TO ISSUE PERMITS AND REGULATE USE OF CROSSBOWS; TO EXTEND THE REPEALER; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
