

Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1620

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5 **SECTION 1.** The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7 Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi State Board of
8 Psychology, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the board
9 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending
10 June 30, 2006..... \$ 73,361.00.

11 **SECTION 2.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
12 Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
13 expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
14 expenditure:

31 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
32 Mississippi State Board of Psychology shall maintain complete
33 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all
34 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be
35 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal
36 Year 2005. It is further the intention of the Legislature that
37 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be
38 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format
39 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
40 provided during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process.

41 **SECTION 4.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
42 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
43 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
44 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
45 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
46 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

47 **SECTION 5.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
48 and after July 1, 2005.
