31 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the

32 State Board of Optometry shall maintain complete accounting and

33 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds

34 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the

35 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year

36 2005. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the

37 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be submitted to

38 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of

39 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided

40 during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process.

41 **SECTION 4.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by

42 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the

credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon

44 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal

45 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the

46 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

47 **SECTION 5.** This act shall take effect and be in force from

48 and after July 1, 2005.
