Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1631

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

7	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be

Full Time..... 36 Time-Limited: 37 Part Time..... 38 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 39 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 40 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 41 Services" for Fiscal Year 2007 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2006 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 42 43 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2007 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 44 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 45 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 46 47 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 48 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 49 50 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2006 appropriation for "Personal 51 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 52 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 53 Services, " the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 54 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2006 "Personal Services" 55 56 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 57 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 58 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 59 60 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 61 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 62 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 63 64 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 65 66 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions

- 67 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 68 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 69
- 70 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 71
- 72 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 73 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 74 Board of Trustees of the Public Employees' Retirement System shall
- 75 maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the
- expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such 76
- 77 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as
- 78 maintained for Fiscal Year 2005. It is further the intention of
- 79 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year
- 80 2007 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee
- in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level 81
- 82 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request
- 83 process.
- 84 SECTION 4. In accordance with the purposes of this article,
- 85 there shall be established in the State Treasury the Public
- Employees' Retirement System Building Repair and Maintenance Fund, 86
- 87 into which shall be deposited all funds collected as rental income
- 88 from the building owned by the system located at 301 North
- 89 President Street, Jackson, Mississippi. At the end of each fiscal
- 90 year, any and all unexpended funds shall be transferred to the
- 91 Administrative Budget Fund of the system.
- It is the intention of the Legislature that the system have 92
- 93 the authority to escalate the Public Employees' Retirement System
- 94 Building Repair and Maintenance Fund in an amount not to exceed
- Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) for repair and 95
- 96 maintenance of the buildings owned by the system.
- expenditures from the Public Employees' Retirement System Building 97
- 98 Repair and Maintenance Fund shall be in accordance with this
- 99 article and for the purposes designated herein.
- 100 SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 101

credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from
and after July 1, 2005.
