Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1632

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

6	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much the	ereof as may be
7	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State

9	revolving fund, for the purpose of defraying the	expenses of the

13	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under	the provisions of

33	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of	
34	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to	
35	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal	
36	ervices" for Fiscal Year 2007 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2006	
37	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions	
38	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2007 budget by the	
39	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the	
40	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall	
41	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all	
42	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this	
43	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure	
44	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual	
45	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2006 appropriation for "Personal	
46	Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.	
47	If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal	
48	Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency	
49	has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this	
50	projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2006 "Personal Services"	
51	appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which	
52	reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation	
53	requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until	
54	such time as the requirements of this provision are met.	
55	Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with	
56	the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or	
57	llowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State	
58	Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written	
59	approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The	
60	Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written	
61	pproval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions	
62	without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the	
63	appropriated level.	
64	No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be	
65	used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are	

- 66 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 67 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 68 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 69 Veterans' Home Purchase Board shall maintain complete accounting
- 70 and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
- 71 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the
- 72 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year
- 73 2005. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the
- 74 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be submitted to
- 75 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
- 76 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
- 77 during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process.
- 78 **SECTION 4.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, the sum
- 79 of Twenty Million Dollars (\$20,000,000.00), or so much thereof as
- 80 may be available, shall come from the issuance and sale of revenue
- 81 bonds authorized by Chapter 501, Laws of 1985.
- 82 **SECTION 5.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 83 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 84 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 85 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 86 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 87 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 88 **SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 89 and after July 1, 2005.
