Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1644

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
8	defraying the expenses of the Office of Capital Defense Counsel of
9	the State of Mississippi for the fiscal year beginning
10	July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006\$ 657,169.00.
11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
13	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Office of Capital
14	Defense Counsel of the State of Mississippi for the purpose of
15	defraying the expenses of the office for the fiscal year beginning
16	July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006 \$ 120,000.00.
17	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
18	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
19	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
20	expenditure:

42	the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.
43	No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
44	used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
45	being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
46	act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
47	SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
48	Office of Capital Defense Counsel shall maintain complete
49	accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all
50	funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be
51	in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal
52	Year 2005. It is further the intention of the Legislature that
53	the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be
54	submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format
55	and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
56	provided during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process.
57	SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
58	Director of the Office of Capital Defense Counsel shall have the
59	authority to accept, budget and expend any source funds, not to
60	exceed Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00). Such funds are
61	to be escalated in accordance with the rules and regulations of
62	the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner
63	consistent with escalation of federal funds.
64	SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by

the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the

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- credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 66
- warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 67
- 68 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 69 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from 70
- and after July 1, 2005. 71
