Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

27	SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
28	State Board of Registration for Foresters shall maintain complete
29	accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all

32 Year 2005. It is further the intention of the Legislature that

33 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be

34 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format

35 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail

37 **SECTION 4.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by

38 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the

39 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon

warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal

Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the

42 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
