Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1655

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
8	defraying the expenses of the Department of Archives and History
9	for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending
10	June 30, 2006\$ 7,933,177.00.
11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
13	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Department of
14	Archives and History which is comprised of special source funds
15	collected by or otherwise available to the department, for the
16	purpose of defraying the expenses of the department for the fiscal
17	year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006
18	\$ 3,227,270.00.
19	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
20	Sections 1 and 2, not more than the amounts set forth below shall
21	be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
22	expenditure:

44	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
45	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
46	Services" for Fiscal Year 2007 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2006
47	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
48	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2007 budget by the
49	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
50	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
51	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
52	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
53	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
54	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
55	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2006 appropriation for "Personal
56	Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
57	If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
58	Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
59	has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
60	projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2006 "Personal Services"
61	appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
62	reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
63	requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
64	such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

65 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 66 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 67 68

Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written

approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 69

Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 70

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71 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions

72 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the

73 appropriated level.

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74 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 75 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 76 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 77 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Department of Archives and History shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2005. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process.

The Mississippi Department of Archives and History is hereby authorized to accept and expend any grant, donation or contribution from any individual, public or private organization, or government entity for purposes of defraying the operational costs of the department. Such grants, donations or contributions shall be received and expended under the rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

SECTION 6. It is the intent of the Legislature that the Mississippi Department of Archives and History shall charge the maximum amount allowable for services rendered, consistent with the cost of providing such services. The funds derived from these

100	charges shall be deposited into a special fund account in the
101	State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Department of
102	Archives and History.
103	SECTION 7. It is the intent of the Legislature that no part
104	of the funds herein appropriated shall be required to be used for
105	the payment of rent for the museum and public space in the State
106	Historical Museum, Old Capitol Restoration.
107	SECTION 8. In addition to all other sums herein
108	appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
109	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds from the Local
110	Government Records Fund in the State Treasury to defray the cost
111	of such program for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and
112	ending June 30, 2006\$ 76,918.00.

- 173 **SECTION 10.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 174 Department of Archives and History is hereby authorized to accept,
- 175 budget and expend funds, not to exceed Five Hundred Thousand
- 176 Dollars (\$500,000.00), from special funds in the State Treasury to
- 177 the credit of the State Treasury fund created in Section
- 178 27-19-56.69(8), Mississippi Code of 1972, for the purpose of
- 179 paying the costs of repair and renovation of the New Capitol, in
- 180 accordance with rules and regulations of the Department of Finance
- 181 and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of
- 182 federal funds.
- 183 **SECTION 11.** Of the funds provided under the provisions of
- 184 this act, One Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$110,000.00) is
- 185 provided for the purpose of developing, maintaining and operating
- 186 Beauvoir Shrine, the last home of Jefferson Davis, the only
- 187 President of the Confederate States of America.
- 188 **SECTION 12.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 189 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 190 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 191 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 192 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 193 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 194 SECTION 13. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 195 and after July 1, 2005.
