## Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1658

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be				
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State				
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of				
8	defraying the expenses of the Grand Gulf Military Monument				
9	Commission in the operation and maintenance of the Grand Gulf				
10	Military Monument for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and				
11	ending June 30, 2006\$ 210,673.00.				
12	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be				
13	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special				
14	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Grand Gulf				
15	Military Monument Commission, for the purpose of defraying the				
16	expenses of the commission in the operation and maintenance of the				
17	Grand Gulf Military Monument for the fiscal year beginning				
18	July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006 \$ 68,308.00.				
19	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of				
20	Sections 1 and 2, not more than the amounts set forth below shall				
21	be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of				
22	expenditure:

43 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 44 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 45 46 Services" for Fiscal Year 2007 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2006 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 47 48 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2007 budget by the 49 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 50 51 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 52 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 53 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. 54 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 55 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2006 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 56 57 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 58 59 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 60 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2006 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 61 62 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 63 64 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

65 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 66 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. 67 The State 68 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 69 The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 70 71 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 72 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 73 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

78 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 79 Grand Gulf Military Monument Commission shall maintain complete 80 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 81 82 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 83 Year 2005. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be 84 85 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 86 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 87 provided during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process.

88 SECTION 5. It shall be unlawful for any officer, employee or 89 other person whatsoever to use or permit or authorize the use of 90 any automobile or any other motor vehicle owned by the State of 91 Mississippi or any department, agency or institution thereof for 92 any purpose other than upon the official business of the State of 93 Mississippi or any agency, department or institution thereof.

94 It is the intent of the Legislature that motor vehicles 95 authorized to be owned and operated by this agency shall comply 96 with Sections 25-1-77 through 25-1-93, Mississippi Code of 1972.

97 **SECTION 6.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 98 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 99 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 100 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 101 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 102 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 103 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from 104 and after July 1, 2005.
