Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1662

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
5	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
6	Treasury to the credit of the State Fire Academy Fund, for the
7	purpose of defraying the expenses of the academy for the fiscal
8	year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006
9	\$ 3,776,584.00.
10	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
11	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
12	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
13	expenditure:

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30 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 31 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 32 33 Services" for Fiscal Year 2007 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2006 34 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 35 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2007 budget by the 36 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 37 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 38 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 39 40 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 41 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 42 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2006 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 43 44 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 45 Services, " the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 46 47 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2006 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 48 49 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 50 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 51 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 52 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 53 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 54 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 55 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 56 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 57 58 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 59 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 60 appropriated level. 61 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be

used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are

being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this

act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

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65 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the

66 State Fire Academy shall maintain complete accounting and

67 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds

68 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the

69 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year

70 2005. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the

71 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be submitted to

72 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of

73 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided

74 during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process.

75 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the

76 State Fire Academy shall have the authority to escalate and expend

77 funds, not to exceed One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars

78 (\$150,000.00), from any source that may become available to the

79 agency in accordance with the rules and regulations of the

80 Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent

81 with the escalation of federal funds.

82 **SECTION 5.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by

83 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the

84 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon

85 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal

86 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the

87 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

88 **SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect and be in force from

89 and after July 1, 2005.
