Adopted COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO

House Bill No. 524

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

6 SECTION 1. Section 37-103-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows: 8 For purposes of determining whether a person pays 9 out-of-state or in-state tuition for attendance at universities, 10 community and junior colleges, the residence of a person less than twenty-one (21) years of age is that of the father, the mother or 11 12 a general guardian duly appointed by a proper court in Mississippi. If a court has granted custody of the minor to one 13 (1) parent, the residence of the minor is that of the parent who 14 was granted custody by the court * * *. If both parents are dead, 15 16 the residence of the minor is that of the last surviving parent at the time of that parent's death, unless the minor lives with a 17 general guardian * * * duly appointed by a proper court of 18 19 Mississippi, in which case his residence becomes that of the 20 guardian. A student who, upon registration at a Mississippi institution of higher learning or community college, presents a 21 22 transcript demonstrating graduation from a Mississippi secondary 23 school and who has been a secondary school student in Mississippi 24 for not less than the final four (4) years of secondary school

- 25 attendance shall not be required to pay out of state tuition.
- 26 This section shall not apply to the residence of a person as it
- 27 relates to residency for voter registration or voting.
- 28 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 29 and after July 1, 2005.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-103-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
- 2 TO CLARIFY THE RESIDENCE STATUS OF MINOR STUDENTS FOR THE PURPOSE
- 3 OF ATTENDANCE AT UNIVERSITIES AND COMMUNITY COLLEGES; AND FOR
- 4 RELATED PURPOSES.
