Lost COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO

House Bill No. 1455

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

7 SECTION 1. Section 59-11-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8 amended as follows:

9 59-11-3. (1) Any county port and harbor commission created pursuant to Section 59-11-1 shall be appointed as follows: two 10 (2) members shall be appointed by the Governor, one (1) from each 11 of the two (2) municipalities of the county, which appointments 12 13 shall be made from those persons recommended and nominated by the governing authorities of the municipalities, and shall be 14 qualified electors of the county; and five (5) members shall be 15 16 appointed by the board of supervisors of such county, each 17 supervisor to recommend the appointment of one (1) member thereof. The members of the county port and harbor commission shall serve 18 for terms concurrent with that of the Governor and the board of 19 20 supervisors making such appointment.

(2) Each member of the county port and harbor commission
shall receive per diem compensation in the amount of Fifty-five
Dollars (\$55.00) for each day engaged in attendance of meetings of
the county port and harbor commission, <u>or when engaged in other</u>
duties of the county port and harbor commission, not to exceed one

26 hundred twenty (120) days in any one year and shall be reimbursed

27 for mileage and actual travel expenses at the rate authorized for

28 county employees under Section 25-3-41.

29 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

30 and after its passage.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 59-11-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO CLARIFY THE AUTHORITY OF MEMBERS OF A COUNTY PORT AND HARBOR COMMISSION TO RECEIVE PER DIEM WHEN ENGAGED IN DUTIES OF THE COMMISSION; TO CLARIFY THE NUMBER OF DAYS THAT PORT COMMISSIONERS MAY RECEIVE COMPENSATION IN ONE YEAR; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
