51	in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal	
52	Year 2005. It is further the intention of the Legislature that	
53	the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be	

54 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format

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55 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 56 provided during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process.

57 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 58 Director of the Office of Capital Defense Counsel shall have the 59 authority to accept, budget and expend any source funds, not to 60 exceed Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00). Such funds are 61 to be escalated in accordance with the rules and regulations of 62 the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner 63 consistent with escalation of federal funds.

SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 64 65 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 66 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 67 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 68 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 69 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from 70 and after July 1, 2005. 71
