5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State

11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in any special
13	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Department of
14	Marine Resources for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and
15	ending June 30, 2006\$ 7,733,307.00
16	Of the funds appropriated in this section, Three Million
17	Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$3,050,000.00) is derived from the state
18	excise taxes upon gasoline, oil and other petroleum products.
19	SECTION 3. With the funds appropriated under the provisions
20	of Sections 1 and 2, not more than the amounts set forth below
21	shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
22	expenditure:

44	furnished an allowance for uniforms not to exceed Four Hundred
45	Fifty Dollars (\$450.00) per annum.
46	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
47	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
48	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
49	Services" for Fiscal Year 2007 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2006
50	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
51	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2007 budget by the
52	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
53	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
54	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
55	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this

- 56 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
- 57 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
- 58 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2006 appropriation for "Personal
- 59 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
- 60 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
- 61 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
- 62 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
- 63 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2006 "Personal Services"
- 64 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- 65 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- 66 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 67 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 69 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 70 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 71 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 72 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 73 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 74 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 75 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 76 appropriated level.
- 77 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 78 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 79 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 80 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 81 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 82 Department of Marine Resources shall maintain complete accounting
- 83 and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
- 84 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the
- 85 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year
- 86 2005. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the
- 87 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be submitted to

- the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 88
- detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 89
- during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process. 90
- 91 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 92 Department of Marine Resources shall have the authority to
- receive, budget and expend funds from any source that may become 93
- available to the department in accordance with the rules and 94
- regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a 95
- manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds. 96
- 97 SECTION 6. In addition to all other sums heretofore
- 98 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
- necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 99
- Treasury to the credit of the Tidelands Fund No. 3452 to the 100
- 101 Department of Marine Resources for the purpose of defraying the
- 102 expenses of the Tidelands projects for the fiscal year beginning
- July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006..... \$ 6,600,000.00. 103

It is the intention of the Legislature that the Tidelands 189 funds appropriated in this act for Tidelands Project No. FY06-M19A 190 Federal Grant Matching Funds - Mississippi Coastal Habitat 191 192 Creation and Restoration and Tidelands Project No. FY06-M19A Federal Grant Matching Funds - Grand Bay NERR Construction be 193 194 reallocated on a pro rata basis between projects listed in this section if the federal funds are not awarded for these two (2) 195 196 projects. 197 SECTION 7. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby reappropriated out of any money in the State 198 Treasury to the credit of the Department of Marine Resources, 199 Tidelands Fund, which is comprised of special source funds 200 201 available to the department, for expenditures pursuant to House 202 Bill No. 1733, 2004 Regular Session, for the fiscal year beginning 203 July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006...... \$6,600,000.00 204 SECTION 8. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 205 commission shall place any special trust funds appropriated to the 206 department in a special trust fund and the interest earned on the principal shall be credited to the special trust fund. Monies in 207 208 the fund at the end of the fiscal year shall be retained in the 209 special trust fund for use in the next succeeding fiscal year. 210 The department may use the interest earned on the fund to pay 211 reasonable costs for administering the fund and related projects. 212 SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that if the amount of

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216	excess Tidelands Funds by the Department of Marine Resources for
217	supplemental and additional funding and administration of
218	tidelands projects heretofore or hereafter proposed is authorized
219	and approved. The Department of Marine Resources may escalate the
220	Tidelands Fund in an amount not to exceed Eight Hundred Thousand
221	Dollars (\$800,000.00) for the purposes outlined in this section.
222	It is the intention of the Legislature that the Department of
223	Marine Resources be allowed to make necessary transfers from the
224	Subsidies, Loans and Grants category of expenditures to any other
225	categories of expenditures for the purpose of expending Tidelands
226	funds.
227	SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
228	Department of Marine Resources has the authorization to move
229	Tidelands funds between approved projects upon request from entity
230	and proper completion of Form TTF-6 documentation.
231	SECTION 11. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
232	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
233	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
234	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
235	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
236	proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
