Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
8	defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Arts Commission for the
9	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006
10	\$ 1,115,507.00.
11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
13	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Arts
14	Commission which is comprised of special source funds and
15	donations collected by or otherwise available to the commission,
16	for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the commission for
17	the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006.
18	\$ 1,535,838.00.
19	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
20	Section 1 and Section 2, not more than the amounts set forth below
21	shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
22	expenditure:

43	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
44	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
45	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
46	Services" for Fiscal Year 2007 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2006
47	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
48	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2007 budget by the
49	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
50	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
51	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
52	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
53	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
54	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
55	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2006 appropriation for "Personal

- Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 56
- 57 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
- 58 Services, " the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
- 59 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
- 60 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2006 "Personal Services"
- 61 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- 62 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 63
- 64 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- 65 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 66 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 67 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 68 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 69
- 70 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 71 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 72 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 73 appropriated level.
- 74 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 75 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 76 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 77 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 78 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 79 Mississippi Arts Commission shall maintain complete accounting and
- 80 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
- appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the 81
- same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 82
- 2005. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 83
- agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be submitted to 84
- the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 85
- 86 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
- 87 during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process.

SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 88 Section 2, funds in the amount of Four Hundred Fifty Thousand 89 Dollars (\$450,000.00) shall be derived from the Education 90 91 Enhancement Fund pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 and 27-67-31, 92 Mississippi Code of 1972, for the following: 93 Training of educators and promotion 94 of arts programs in public schools . . . \$100,000.00 95 Miscellaneous grants and programs \$350,000.00 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 96 97 Arts Commission shall have the authority to transfer dollars 98 appropriated in the major object of expenditure "Subsidies, Loans and Grants, " designated for the "Challenge Program, " specific 99 100 amounts to a special fund in the State Treasury called the Arts 101 Commission Challenge Initiative Fund. The unexpended amounts remaining in the fund at the end of a fiscal year shall not lapse 102 103 into the State General Fund and may be expended by the commission 104 in subsequent fiscal years upon appropriation of the Legislature. 105 Any interest earned on the fund shall be deposited to the credit 106 of the fund and may be disbursed by the commission upon 107 appropriations of the Legislature. It is the intention of the 108 Legislature that the commission may award grants to arts 109 organizations from monies in the fund and the grantees will be 110 required to provide matching funds for the grants in an amount of not less than two (2) times the amount of the grant. 111 112 SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi Arts Commission shall have the authority to escalate 113 114 its budget and expend funds from any source available not to exceed Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00), that may 115 become available to the commission in accordance with the rules 116 and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in 117 a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds. 118

119	SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
120	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
121	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
122	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
123	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
124	proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law
125	SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from
126	and after July 1, 2005.
