Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. (1) There is created a Task Force to Study the
6	Administrative Consolidation of School Districts in Mississippi.
7	The task force shall, at a minimum, study and report on the
8	following factors related to school consolidation:
9	(a) Administrative costs of school districts;
10	(b) Local contributions to MAEP;
11	(c) Optimum size of school districts;
12	(d) Methods of selecting school boards and school
13	superintendents;
14	(e) High growth districts; and
15	(f) Related issues.
16	(2) The State Board of Education shall contract with a
17	consulting firm that has expertise in public school administration
18	to assist the task force with the study, or may contract for
19	services to be provided by the Stennis Institute for Government.
20	The task force shall make a report of its findings and
21	recommendations to the Legislature by November 1, 2005, including
22	any recommended legislation.

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(3) The task force shall be composed of the following twelve(12) members:

(a) The Chairmen of the House and Senate EducationCommittees;

(b) The Chairmen of the House and Senate AppropriationCommittees;

(c) Two (2) representatives to be appointed by the
Speaker of the House, at least one (1) of which shall be a member
of the Joint Legislative Budget Committee;

32 (d) Two (2) Senators to be appointed by the Lieutenant
33 Governor, at least one (1) of which shall be a member of the Joint
34 Legislative Budget Committee;

35 (e) The State Superintendent of Education, or his36 designee;

37 (f) An appointed and elected school superintendent38 appointed by the Governor;

39 (g) An appointed and elected local school board member40 approved by the Governor; and

41 (h) A member of the State Board of Education appointed42 by the Chairman of the board.

(4) Appointments shall be made within thirty (30) days after
the effective date of this act. The task force shall hold its
first meeting before August 1, 2005. The Chairman of the House
Education Committee and the Chairman of the Senate Education
Committee shall serve as cochairmen of the task force.

48 (5) A majority of the members of the task force shall 49 constitute a quorum. In the adoption of rules, resolutions and 50 reports, an affirmative vote of a majority of the task force shall 51 be required. All members shall be notified in writing of all 52 meetings, such notices to be mailed at least five (5) days prior 53 to the date on which a meeting is to be held.

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54 (6) Members of the task force may not be compensated for the 55 performance of their duties. Any incidental costs associated with 56 conducting the study shall be paid by the State Department of 57 Education.

58 (7) The task force is authorized to accept money from any
59 source, public or private, to be expended in implementing its
60 duties under this section.

61 (8) To effectuate the purposes of this section, any 62 department, division, board, bureau, commission or agency of the 63 state or of any political subdivision thereof shall, at the 64 request of the chairperson of the task force, provide to the task 65 force such facilities, assistance and data as will enable the task 66 force to properly carry out its duties.

67 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 68 and after July 1, 2005.
