Amend by inserting the following after line 486 in lieu 1 2 thereof the following: SECTION 1. (1) There is created a Task Force to Study the 3 Administrative Consolidation of School Districts in Mississippi. 4 5 The task force shall, at a minimum, study and report on the following factors related to school consolidation: 6 7 Administrative costs of school districts; (a) Local contributions to MAEP; 8 (b) Optimum size of school districts; 9 (C) Methods of selecting school boards and school 10 (d) 11 superintendents; 12 High growth districts; and (e) 13 (f) Related issues. The State Board of Education shall contract with a 14 (2) consulting firm that has expertise in public school administration 15 to assist the task force with the study, or may contract for 16 services to be provided by the Stennis Institute for Government. 17 18 The task force shall make a report of its findings and recommendations to the Legislature by November 1, 2005, including 19 20 any recommended legislation. 21 (3) The task force shall be composed of the following twelve 22 (14) members: *SS01/SB2713A. 3J* 05/SS01/SB2713A.3J PAGE 1

(a) The Chairmen of the House and Senate EducationCommittees;

(b) The Chairmen of the House and Senate AppropriationCommittees;

(c) Two (2) representatives to be appointed by the
Speaker of the House, at least one (1) of which shall be a member
of the Joint Legislative Budget Committee;

30 (d) Two (2) Senators to be appointed by the Lieutenant
31 Governor, at least one (1) of which shall be a member of the Joint
32 Legislative Budget Committee;

33 (e) The State Superintendent of Education, or his34 designee;

35 (f) An appointed and elected school superintendent 36 appointed by the Governor;

37 (g) An appointed and elected local school board member38 approved by the Governor; and

39 (h) A member of the State Board of Education appointed40 by the Chairman of the board.

(4) Appointments shall be made within thirty (30) days after the effective date of this act. The task force shall hold its first meeting before August 1, 2005. The Chairman of the House Education Committee and the Chairman of the Senate Education Committee shall serve as cochairmen of the task force.

46 (5) A majority of the members of the task force shall 47 constitute a quorum. In the adoption of rules, resolutions and 48 reports, an affirmative vote of a majority of the task force shall 49 be required. All members shall be notified in writing of all 50 meetings, such notices to be mailed at least five (5) days prior 51 to the date on which a meeting is to be held.

52 (6) Members of the task force may not be compensated for the 53 performance of their duties. Any incidental costs associated with 54 conducting the study shall be paid by the State Department of 55 Education.

56 (7) The task force is authorized to accept money from any 57 source, public or private, to be expended in implementing its 58 duties under this section.

59 (8) To effectuate the purposes of this section, any 60 department, division, board, bureau, commission or agency of the 61 state or of any political subdivision thereof shall, at the 62 request of the chairperson of the task force, provide to the task 63 force such facilities, assistance and data as will enable the task 64 force to properly carry out its duties.

65 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 66 and after July 1, 2005.
