HOUSE BILL NO. 2

AN ACT MAKING AN ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION OF GENERAL AND 1 SPECIAL FUNDS TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES OF THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE -2 3 DIVISION OF MEDICAID FOR FISCAL YEAR 2005.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. In addition to all other sums heretofore 5 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 6 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 7 8 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to defray the expenses of the Governor's Office - Division of Medicaid for the fiscal year 9 ending June 30, 2005..... \$ 29,000,000.00. 10

SECTION 2. In addition to all other sums heretofore 11 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 12 13 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the Working Cash-Stabilization Reserve Fund created in Section 27-103-203, 14 15 Mississippi Code of 1972, not otherwise appropriated, to defray the expenses of the Governor's Office - Division of Medicaid for 16 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2005..... \$ 20,600,000.00. 17

SECTION 3. In addition to all other sums heretofore 18 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 19 20 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 21 Treasury to the credit of the Governor's Office - Division of 22 Medicaid, which is comprised of any special source funds collected by or otherwise available to the division, for the purpose of 23 defraying the expenses of the division, for the fiscal year ending 24 June 30, 2005.....\$ 200,000.00. 25

SECTION 4. This additional appropriation is made for the 26 purpose of funding the medical and administrative services 27 provided by the Governor's Office - Division of Medicaid. 28 29 SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 30 the State Treasurer out of any money in the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal 31 Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants 32 upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers 33 in the manner provided by law. 34

35 **SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 36 and after its passage.
