HOUSE BILL NO. 28 (As Passed the House)

AN ACT APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF SPECIAL FUNDS FOR THE 1 PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE STATE BOARD OF 2 3 COSMETOLOGY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2006. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 7 Treasury to the credit of the State Board of Cosmetology, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the board for the fiscal year 8 beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006..... 9 .....\$ 736,038.00. 10 SECTION 2. 31 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 32 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 33 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2007 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2006 34 35 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2007 budget by the 36 37 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 38 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 39 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 40 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 41 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. 42 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2006 appropriation for "Personal 43 44 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 45 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 46 47 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2006 "Personal Services" 48 49 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 50 51 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 52 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

66 The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise 67 award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification, realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other 68 69 means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless 70 specifically exempted by the following conditions: the award of teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the 71 72 next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public 73 74 Accountant License or higher level professional certification as determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement 75 76 of a departing employee with an individual from within state 77 service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses, 78 79 pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be 80 determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise 81 authorized in this act.

SECTION 3. If not needed for other purposes, the State 82 83 Treasurer shall invest any part of or all monies herein approved 84 and any surplus funds of the State Board of Cosmetology for a period of ninety (90) days or more at the highest rate of interest 85 86 obtainable and credit such to this respective fund. Monies shall 87 be invested by the Treasurer in any short-term bonds, notes or other direct obligations of the United States of America or the 88 State of Mississippi or any county or municipality of this state, 89 90 which county or municipal bonds have been approved by a reputable 91 bond attorney or have been validated by a decree of the court, or in savings accounts or certificates of deposit of a state or 92 \*HR40/A822PH\*

No. 28 052E/HR40/A822PH PAGE 3 (RM\ST\BD) 93 national bank in the State of Mississippi, or in federally insured 94 savings and loan associations in the State of Mississippi; and in 95 any event, the bonds, notes or obligations in which such funds are 96 invested shall mature or be redeemable prior to the time the funds 97 so invested will be needed for the purposes herein provided.

98 **SECTION 4.** It is the intent of this legislation to provide 99 the funds for the board to meet when necessary, but under no 100 circumstances shall it meet more than sixty-two (62) days a year.

SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 101 102 State Board of Cosmetology shall maintain complete accounting and 103 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the 104 105 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 106 It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 2005 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be submitted to 107 108 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 109 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 110 during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process.

SECTION 6. Of the funds provided herein, the sum of Thirty-two Thousand One Hundred Thirty-five Dollars (\$32,135.00) is hereby assessed on any non-federal special funds and shall be deposited to the Budget Contingency Fund created in Section 27-103-301, Mississippi Code of 1972, on or before October 1, 2005, for the purpose of reimbursing the State of Mississippi for administrative costs.

118 **SECTION 7.** None of the monies appropriated under this act 119 shall be expended for payment of that amount of the salary of any person holding the position of division director, department 120 director or head, bureau director, deputy or assistant director or 121 similar position on May 15, 2005, which would exceed the amount 122 123 actually paid for the same position on June 30, 2003, regardless 124 of the title or position held or duties performed by the person holding the position on June 30, 2003. 125

**SECTION 8.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 126 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 127 128 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 129 130 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 131 **SECTION <u>9.</u>** This act shall take effect and be in force from 132 and after July 1, 2005. 133
