HOUSE BILL NO. 31

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM SPECIAL FUNDS IN THE 1 2 STATE TREASURY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE 3 MISSISSIPPI STATE BOARD OF PHYSICAL THERAPY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 4 2006. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 6 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 7 8 Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi State Board of Physical 9 Therapy, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi State Board of Physical Therapy for the fiscal year 10 beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006..... 11\$ 195,700.00. 12 SECTION 2. With the funds appropriated under the provisions 13 of Section 1, the following positions are authorized: 14 AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: 15 16 Permanent: Full Time..... 2 17 Part Time..... 1 Time-Limited: Full Time..... 18 0 Part Time..... 19 0 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 20 21 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 22 Services" for Fiscal Year 2007 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2006 23 24 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2007 budget by the 25 26 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 27 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 28 *HR05/A837* N1/2 H. B. 29 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 30 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 31 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2006 appropriation for "Personal 32 33 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 34 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 35 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 36 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2006 "Personal Services" 37 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 38 39 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 40 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 41

42 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 43 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 44 45 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 46 The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 47 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 48 49 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 50 appropriated level.

51 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 52 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 53 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 54 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification, realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless specifically exempted by the following conditions: the award of teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an

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educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public 62 63 Accountant License or higher level professional certification as determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement 64 65 of a departing employee with an individual from within state 66 service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the 67 departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses, pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be 68 determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise 69 70 authorized in this act.

SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 71 72 Mississippi State Board of Physical Therapy shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the 73 74 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such 75 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2005. It is further the intention of 76 77 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 78 2007 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee 79 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request 80 81 process.

SECTION 4. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 82 83 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 84 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 85 86 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 87 88 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from 89 and after July 1, 2005.

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
