HOUSE BILL NO. 36 (As Passed the House)

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING 1 THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI VETERANS MEMORIAL STADIUM 2 3 COMMISSION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2006. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Veterans Memorial 7 8 Stadium Fund, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission for the fiscal 9 year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006..... 10 \$ 1,179,129.00. 11 In addition to the funds appropriated herein, the Mississippi 12 13 Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission is hereby authorized to disburse to participating institutions, agencies or departments 14 15 their shares or divisions of gate receipts. SECTION 2. 40 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 41 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 42 Services" for Fiscal Year 2007 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2006 43 44 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 45 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2007 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 46 47 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 48 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 49 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 50 act. 51 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 52 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2006 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 53 54 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 55 56 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2006 "Personal Services" 57 58 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 59 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation

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62 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 63 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 64 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 65 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 66 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 67 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 68 69 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 70 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise 75 76 award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification, 77 realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless 78 79 specifically exempted by the following conditions: the award of 80 teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the 81 next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public 82 83 Accountant License or higher level professional certification as 84 determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement of a departing employee with an individual from within state 85 86 service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the 87 departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses, pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be 88 determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise 89 90 authorized in this act.

91 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 92 Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission shall maintain H. B. No. 36 *HR40/A861PH* 052E/HR40/A861PH

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complete accounting and personnel records related to the 93 94 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as 95 96 maintained for Fiscal Year 2005. It is further the intention of 97 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 98 2007 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level 99 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request 100 101 process.

SECTION 4. None of the monies appropriated under this act 102 103 shall be expended for payment of that amount of the salary of any 104 person holding the position of division director, department 105 director or head, bureau director, deputy or assistant director or 106 similar position on May 15, 2005, which would exceed the amount 107 actually paid for the same position on June 30, 2003, regardless 108 of the title or position held or duties performed by the person 109 holding the position on June 30, 2003.

110 **SECTION 5.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 111 112 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 113 114 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 115 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 116 117 and after July 1, 2005.
